Ecclesiastes 3:11 (NIV) *“He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.”*

1 Peter 3:13 (NIV) *“Who is going to harm you if you are eager to do good?”*

If our love for God leads to a hate for the people Jesus died for, things are not going right. Something is **out of order**.

Two Takeaway Truths:

1. Your passion for God protects you.

1 Peter 3:14 (NIV) *“But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. ‘Do not fear their threats; do not be frightened.’”*

Galatians 1:10 (NIV) *“Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ.”*

Isaiah 8:12 (NIV) *“Do not call conspiracy everything this people calls a conspiracy; do not fear what they fear, and do not dread it.”*

Luke 12:5 (NIV) *“But I will show you whom you should fear: Fear Him who, after your body has been killed, has authority to throw you into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear Him.”*

When we care more about God than we do about life on this earth, that is when grace has taught our hearts to fear and relieved our earthly fears.

1 Peter 3:14 (Amplified Bible) *“But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness [though it is not certain that you will], you are still blessed [happy, to be admired and favored by God]. Do not be afraid of their intimidating threats, nor be troubled or disturbed [by their opposition].”*

1 Peter 3:18 (NIV) *“For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive in the Spirit.”*

2. Your adoration for God prepares you.

1 Peter 3:15-16 (NIV) *“But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect,¹⁶ keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.”*

You can't be prepared if you won't prepare.

Lamentations 3:22-23 (NIV) *“Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail.²³ They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.”*

Lamentations 3:22-23 (NASB) *“The Lord's acts of mercy indeed do not end, for His compassions do not fail.²³ They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.”*

**Prepare in adoration/worship every day.
Set apart Christ as Lord in your heart.
There is an order to everything**

1 John 4:19 (NIV) *“We love because He first loved us.”*

Matthew 14:28 (GNT) *“Then Peter spoke up. ‘Lord, if it is really You, order me to come out on the water to You.’”*

right now, under orders.**

Philippians 4:6 (NIV) *“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.”*
