GOD CALLS MOSES TO LEAD HIS PEOPLE

God:

“And now the cry of the Israelites has reached Me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them.”¹⁰
So now, go. I Am sending you to Pharaoh to bring My people the Israelites out of Egypt.” (Exodus 3:9-10 NIV)

Moses:

“Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?” (Exodus 3:11 NIV)

God:

“I will be with you.” (Exodus 3:12a NIV)

Moses:

“Lord, I’ve never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue.” (Exodus 4:10 NIV)

God:

“Now go; I will help you speak and I will teach you what to say.” (Exodus 4:12 NIV)

Moses:

“Pardon your servant, Lord. Please send someone else.” (Exodus 4:13 NIV)

SOLUTIONS FOR INSECURITY...

1. Change Your Thinking

Jesus challenged the thinking of His listeners.
Then He flipped their thought process upside down.

Romans 12:2 (NLT) *“Don’t copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God’s will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.”*

Psalm 8:3-5 (NLT) *“When I look at the night sky and see the work of Your fingers – the moon and the stars You set in place –⁴ what are mere mortals that You should think about them, human beings that You should care for them?⁵ Yet You made them only a little lower than God and crowned them with glory and honor.”*

2. Embrace Your Uniqueness

Psalm 139:13 (NIV) *“For You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother’s womb.”*
