John 15:5&8 (NIV) "I am the Vine; you are the branches. If you remain in Me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing. ⁸ This is to My Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be My disciples."

Matthew 7:16-17 (NIV) "By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷ Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit."

People won't just know you by what you say, but by how you live.

Galatians 5:22-23 (NASB) "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law."

When others look at you, what do they see?

Romans 8:5 (NIV) "Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires."

Sarx: It means your fleshly nature.
Your fleshly nature wants to do what is selfish.
Your Spiritual nature wants to do what is God honoring.

Matthew 7:15 (NIV) "Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves."

Jesus didn't call us to dress up the flesh but rather to crucify it.

Luke 9:23 (NIV) "Then He said to them all: 'Whoever wants to be My disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."
