God's will is more about a who than a do.

Are you becoming more like Jesus?

Before God guides your steps, He wants to shape your character.

**Matthew 6:34 (NLT)** "So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today."

**Matthew 6:34 (NIV)** "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

James 4:13-15 (NIV) "Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money.' 14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. 15 Instead, you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."

If you want to know God's will get to know God's heart.

**Psalm 37:4 (NIV)** "Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart."

The more you get to know God's heart, the more you live His will.

Before you worry about God's will for the future, worry about His Moral Will for how you live today.

**2 Timothy 1:9 (NLT)** "For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was His plan from before the beginning of time—to show us His grace through Christ Jesus."

Instead of: What do You want me to do? Ask: Who do You want me to become?

**1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV)** "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."

God, what area of my life do You want to transform to help me become more like Jesus?

Proverbs 29:18 (KJV) "Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he." Proverbs 29:18 (NASB) "Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, but happy is one who keeps the Law."

To do big things in the future... do small things for the glory of God today.
