Three Primary Angel Responsibilities

- **They Magnify God.**
- **They are Messengers from God.**

In the Bible, the word “angel,” literally means messenger.

- **They Minister to people.**

Hebrews 13:2 (NIV) “*Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.*”

WHAT IS THE ANGEL'S MESSAGE OF CHRISTMAS?

Luke 2:14 (NIV) “*Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom His favor rests.*”

Isaiah 9:6-7a (NIV) “*For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of His government and peace there will be no end.*”

The angels announce a relationship with God where we choose to live in His favor and then receive His inner peace.

Matthew 22:37-38 (NIV) “*Jesus replied: ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’*”
³⁸ *This is the first and greatest commandment.”*

**When you make Jesus the Lord of your life,

John 14:27 (NIV) “*Peace I leave with you; My peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”*

Luke 1:38 (NIV) “*I am the Lord's servant,’ Mary answered. ‘May your word to me be fulfilled.”*

Luke 2:19 (NIV) “But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart.”

Treasuring and Pondering what God has done and is doing in your life is what leads to peace.

Acts 1:14 (NIV) “They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.”

WAYS TO PRACTICE PEACE...

1. Let go and surrender.

Psalm 46:10a (NIV) “Be still.”

2. Know God as your friend.

Psalm 46:10ab (NIV) “Be still, and know that I am God...”

Jesus is IMMANUEL or... GOD WITH US!

John 14:7 (NIV) “If you really know Me, you will know My Father as well. From now on, you do know Him and have seen Him.”

3. Exalt God as a habit.

Psalm 46:10 (NIV) “Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.”

**Exalt God in every circumstance.
Praise God in your problems.**

4. Be confident in God’s presence.

Psalm 46:11a (NIV) “The Lord Almighty is with us.”

When we recognize that the Lord is with us, we have peace and we know we’re not alone in our problems!

Luke 2:14 (NCV) “Give glory to God in heaven, and on earth let there be peace among the people who please God.”
