Hebrews 11:23 (NIV) “By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict.”

Moses presents the story of a lost identity, a confused identity and a missing identity.

KNOWING YOUR TRUE SPIRITUAL IDENTITY...

1. Demonstrates your Spiritual maturity.

Hebrews 11:24 (NIV) “By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter.”

Spiritual maturity leads to your personal identity.

So much stress in your life comes from not knowing who you are.

John 8:14 (NIV) “Jesus answered, ‘Even if I testify on My own behalf, My testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. But you have no idea where I come from or where I am going.’”

Matthew 20:28 (NLT) “For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give His life as a ransom for many.”

2. Defines your responsibilities.

When you know who you are, you know what your responsibility is and what your responsibility isn't.

God will use every event in your life to accomplish His purposes.

Hebrews 11:25 (NIV) “He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin.”

You Are Spiritually Mature When You...

- Stop blaming others for your life's direction.
- Stop living off someone else's Spiritual commitment.

Romans 14:12 (GW) “All of us will have to give an account of ourselves to God.”

3. Decides your values.

Hebrews 11:26 (NIV) “He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.”

Your vision sets your values.

Philippians 3:8 (CEV) “Nothing is as wonderful as knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. I have given up everything else and count it all as garbage. All I want is Christ.”

4. Determines your destiny.

We want to change our circumstances.
God wants to change us.

Figuring Out Your Destiny...

- **Gives you the courage to leave your past behind.**

Hebrews 11:27 (NLT) “It was by faith that Moses left the land of Egypt, not fearing the king's anger. He kept right on going because he kept his eyes on the One who is invisible.”

When Satan reminds you of your past, you can remind him of his future!

- **Gives you the courage to live as a new person.**

2 Corinthians 5:17 (CEV) “Anyone who belongs to Christ is a new person. The past is forgotten, and everything is new.”

Hebrews 12:2a (GNT) “Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, on whom our faith depends from beginning to end.”
